

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Amendment of the Scott County Ordinance governing dogs in residential districts

ARTICLE I

Enacting Clause, Title, Purpose

1.1 ENACTING CLAUSE

Be it ordained by the Fiscal Court of the County of Scott, Commonwealth of Kentucky.

1.2 TITLE

This ordinance is entitled "Amendment to the County Dog Ordinance, Scott County, Kentucky --- Charges." Certified copies of this ordinance are on file with the Scott County Clerk.

1.3 PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to increase the charges collected by the Scott County Animal Control office. This increase is designated to help meet the rising feed and supply costs for the shelter, to apply greater impact to the owners of dogs in violation of the County Dog Ordinance.

ARTICLE II

Amendment

- 2.3 (5) & (6) shall upon the adoption of this ordinance read hereafter as follows: (5) The following charges shall be paid to the county for the impounding of any dog: cost of impounding or pick-up \$3.00; cost of maintenance \$1.50 per day and cost of notice, \$1.00; adoption fee for adults \$20.00, adoption fee for puppies \$12.50. (6) Any dog found at large belonging to an owner or keeper who can be identified need not be impounded but returned to the owner or keeper upon payment of \$3.00 pick up fee.

ARTICLE III

CONFLICT WITH EXISTING LAW

In the event any section of this ordinance conflicts with existing state law, the conflicting section of this ordinance shall be inapplicable to the extent of the conflict. The provisions of this ordinance shall be in addition to any existing state or local laws.

ARTICLE IV

VALIDITY

If any provision of the Dog Ordinance is held invalid, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such a decision shall not affect the validity of any other provision of the Dog Ordinance.
