

ORDINANCE NO. 10-04

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE AMENDMENT
OF SCOTT COUNTY ORDINANCE # 94-011, PREVIOUSLY
ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 26, 1994 WHICH GOVERNED
THE SOUND AND EFFICIENT ADMINISTRATION OF
COUNTY GOVERNMENT IN SCOTT COUNTY
AND DESIGNATED AS "ADMINISTRATIVE CODE".

WHEREAS, The County of Scott, by and through the Fiscal Court has previously adopted a new "Administrative Code" on September 26, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the "Administrative Code" was given No. 94-011 and adopted by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, § 3.3(G) now requires additional language to clarify re-employment with the County:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF SCOTT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, THAT ORDINANCE # 94-0115 BE AND IS HEREBY AMENDED TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS:


I § 3.3 RE-EMPLOYMENT

Any employee who previously resigned from the County with a satisfactory employment record or who was laid off because of lack of work or funds, may apply for employment in another position, provided the employee meets the qualifications for the position, and the position is vacant. If an employee retires and chooses to be covered by a health insurance plan offered by way of the Kentucky Employee's Retirement System/ County Employee's Retirement System, and is then hired/rehired by the County, then the County will not be responsible for providing said employee with health insurance coverage.

II If any provision of this amended administrative code is held invalid, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decisions shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof.

III This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication according to law.

WHEREUPON, the foregoing amendments to the Administrative Code of Scott County were approved this 13 day of August, 2010.
