 AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCE # 01-04
 AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO THE LOCAL ADOPTION
 OF MANDATORY RADON PROTECTION
 IN ONE AND TWO FAMILY DWELLINGS

WHEREAS, The State Board of Housing, the agency responsible for the adoption of the state building code, has adopted a new code. This new code omits any Radon requirement. The new code will likely be effective on or about September 11. From that date we will not be authorized to require Radon mitigation techniques. Rather than continue defense of this Ordinance, in the face of the State's Board of Housing action, it appears appropriate to repeal Ordinance #01-04.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SCOTT FISCAL COURT, SCOTT COUNTY, KENTUCKY,


That Scott Fiscal Court Ordinance #01-04, related to the local adoption of mandatory radon protection in one and two family dwellings, is repealed.
