ORDINANCE NO. 02-02

AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO THE AMENDMENT  
OF APPENDIX III OF THE GEORGETOWN/SCOTT COUNTY  
SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS

**WHEREAS:** The existing certifications required for subdivision plats and development plans are not satisfying the community's needs. The certifications and review process must be updated to reflect the current professional thinking and address the review of sufficiency of infrastructure and adequate fire protection for new developments;

**WHEREAS:** This proposed amendment to the Georgetown/Scott Subdivision and Development Regulations has been submitted to the citizens through a properly advertised public hearing before the Georgetown-Scott County Planning and Zoning Commission conducted at their December 13, 2001, public meeting. The Commission voted unanimously to recommend the adoption of this amendment to the City and County governments of Scott County;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF SCOTT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, as follows:**

**SECTION ONE: NEW PROVISIONS.** [All language is new.]

1. THE SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, APPENDIX III, is amended to include:

Form Q (on final development plans and final subdivision plats)  
CERTIFICATION OF FIRE DEPARTMENT APPROVAL




**SECTION TWO: EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
