ORDINANCE RE-AFFIRMING AGRICULTURE EXTENSION DISTRICT

AUTHORIZED BY KRS 164.605 et.seq.

An Ordinance re-affirming the establishment of Agriculture Extension District (5 March, 1980) as authorized by KRS 164.605 et seq. and creating a separate taxing district under Kentucky Constitution §157.

WHEREAS, KRS 164.605 et. seq. provides that the Fiscal Court is authorized to create an extension district whose boundaries shall be coexistent with the county boundaries and each such district to constitute a governmental subdivision of the Commonwealth and a public body corporate; and

WHEREAS, the Scott Fiscal Court believes it is useful and desirable to provide for aid in dissemination among its citizens useful and practical information on subjects relating to agriculture, home economics and rural and community life to encourage the application of the same in the County of Scott through extension work to be carried on in cooperation with the U. S. Department of Agriculture as provided in the Act of Congress May 8, 1914;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SCOTT FISCAL COURT as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby authorized by the Scott Fiscal Court an Extension District, the boundaries of which shall be coexistent with the county boundaries, all pursuant to KRS 164.605 et seq.

Section 2. The Extension District shall constitute a governmental subdivision of the Commonwealth and a public body corporate.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.
